## Air Rifle and Air Pistol Marksmanship Competitions

### Camp Perry, Ohio and Anniston, Alabama

The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) invites you and your club rifle team to participate in the CMP's Monthly Matches. The matches will take place on the above dates at the CMP's Marksmanship Centers North and South. The competitions will feature a Junior Air Rifle 3x20, 60 Shots Air Rifle Standing, 60 Shots Air Pistol, a 20 shot Novice Prone stage a National Match Air Rifle 20 Shot Standing, Garand Course and 3x20 events.

#### CMP MARKSMANSHIP CENTERS.

Both ranges have 80 firing points, each equipped with MEGALink electronic targets. All shots are instantly displayed on monitors beside each shooter and on display screens visible to spectators in the center area of



the range.



All firing is controlled by a computer operations center in the middle of the range. The matches will be run simultaneously and all scores will be uploaded to the CMP's Competition Tracker website. Scores from both matches will be compiled to determine winners.

#### EVENTS.

Junior 3x20 - Juniors (as defined by rule 3.1 in the 2008-2010 National Standard Air Rifle Rules) are invited to participate in the 3 position air rifle (3x20) match. The match will conclude with a final for the top 8 competitors in both sporter and precision categories. Awards will be given out at the end of the match. This match is considered a "CMP Cup Match" and EIC points will be awarded to the top 10% of eligible competitors. Results will be combined from north and south facilities when determining EIC points.



Novice Prone Match - This match is designed for beginning shooters between the ages of 8-12 years old and will be fired with Sporter class air rifles. The shooters will fire sighting shots and 20 record shots in the supported prone position on the 200 yard reduced SR target. **An adult chaperone must be present with the shooter at all times to assist with loading and proper gun safety.** There will be a 10 minute preparation period followed by 30 minutes to shoot unlimited sighting shots and 20 record shots. Loaner rifles will be available for anyone who does not have a sporter class air rifle. Novice prone shooters will earn ribbons based on the following cut scores.

60 Shots Air Rifle Standing – The 60 shot standing match will be open to all ages. The match will conclude with a final for the top 8 shooters. Awards will be given out at the end of the match. This event will also be sanctioned with USA Shooting and current membership is required to have scores reported.

60 Shots Air Pistol – The 60 shot Air Pistol match will be open to all ages. The match will conclude with a final for the top 8 shooters. Awards will be given out at the end of the match. This event will also be sanctioned with USA Shooting and current membership is required to have scores reported.

NMAR Competition Events - The new Camp Perry Monthly Match Program offers two competition tracks that are set up to better meet the needs of a wide range of shooters and offer instruction and courses of fire that are appropriate for all. When you sign up for a monthly match, you will be asked to select the track that is most appropriate for you. If you are a new or inexperienced shooter or if your competitive interests are focused primarily on the As-Issued Military Rifle Matches, you are strongly urged to register for Track B.

*Track A—Experienced Shooters.* This track is for experienced rifle shooters who have a highpower or smallbore rifle classification or who have competed in service rifle EIC matches. Track A entry includes 1) Full Course 3x20-shot NMAR event, 2) Coaching or mentoring one or more shooters when they shoot the Sporter-Garand Course. If you don't have an air rifle to use, loaner AR-Clone rifles will be available at the range.

*Track B—New and Recreational Shooters.* This track is for new shooters, recreational shooters and for shooters who want to prepare for As-Issued Military Rifle shooting or the Rifle Small Arms Firing School. Track B includes 1) Sporter-Garand 3x10-shot Course, with coaching from an experienced shooter. If you don't have your own sporter class air rifle, loaner air rifles will be available at the range.

## RULES

- 3x20 - The competition will be governed by the **National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules**. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the CMP website at <http://www.odcmp.com/3P/Rulebook.htm>.
- 60 Shots Air Rifle – The competition will be governed by the **USAS Rifle Rules**. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the USA Shooting website at <http://www.usashooting.com/rulebook.php>.
- 60 Shots Air Pistol – The competition will be governed by the **USAS Pistol Rules**. Copies of the rules may be downloaded from the USA Shooting website at <http://www.usashooting.com/rulebook.php>.

- 3x20 National Match Air Rifle – This competition will be governed by the **CMP Guide to National Match Air Rifle** that is posted on the CMP website at <http://www.odcmp.com/Competitions/NMAR.htm>.

**Clear Barrel Indicator (CBI).** CBIs will be required in the Marksmanship Center, in concert with CMP intent to promote the use of these devices. The CBI is a length of string trimmer line that is inserted through the bore, with ends protruding from the muzzle and the chamber. CBIs provide visual confirmation that the rifle/pistol is unloaded. CBIs must be inserted after rifles or pistols are uncased. CBIs will be available on the range for those that do not have them.

**FEES.**

- Junior 3x20 - \$10
- Novice Prone - \$5
- 60 Shot Air Rifle - \$10 (extra \$5 to have scores reported to USA Shooting)
- 60 Shot Air Pistol - \$10 (extra \$5 to have scores reported to USA Shooting)
- National Match Air Rifle Track A (3x20) - \$20 (*includes rifle rental*)
- National Match Air Rifle Track B (3x10) - \$10 (*includes rifle rental*)

**AWARDS.**

The junior 3x20 event will be broken into Sporter and Precision categories. Both categories will receive 1st, 2nd and 3rd place individual awards as long as there is a minimum of five competitors in each category. If a category does not have the minimum of five shooters, we will award 1st place only.

Competitors in the Novice prone competition will ribbons based on cut scores.

For the 60 shot rifle and pistol matches, we will award 1st, 2nd and 3rd for Open and Junior categories. There is a minimum of five competitors required to award 2nd - 3rd in each category. If a category does not have the minimum of five shooters, we will award 1st place only.

For the NMAR events all competitors will be eligible to earn CMP Gold, Silver or Bronze NMAR Achievement Pins for firing scores that equal or exceed established cut scores for these matches. Awards will be CMP



Gift Certificates that can be applied against purchases at CMP Stores or for E-Store or catalog purchases. If there are two or fewer competitors in the Sporter Class, they will be combined into the AR-Clone Class. If there are two or fewer competitors in the AR-Clone Class, they will be combined into the Match Rifle Class.

**HOUSING.**

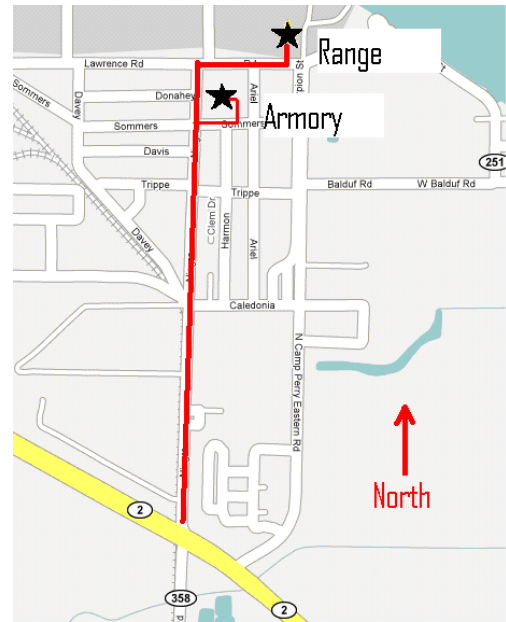

Competitors over the age of 18 must complete and sign our release form (affidavit). Shooters under the age of 18 must have a Parent Consent form completed. ## DIRECTIONS TO RANGES.

### Camp Perry, OH

Camp Perry is located approximately five miles west of Port Clinton on Ohio state highway #2. The Camp Perry entrance is on the north side of hwy #2 and is marked by two lighthouses. Proceed north on the Camp Perry entrance road. From the Main Gate continue on the entrance road until you reach the stop sign at Sommers Rd. Go straight at the STOP sign to Lawrence Rd. Turn Right on Lawrence Rd. You will see a garage door covered range on your left. As soon as the covered range ends, turn left into the large parking lot. The CMP Competition Center is a new building located next to the covered range. A map has been provided (right).



### Anniston, AL

From I-20, exit 188.

1. Head north on Golden Springs Road/Leon Smith Pkwy, continue to follow Golden Springs Road 1.2 miles.
2. Turn left at Greenbrier Dear Road 0.3 miles.
3. Turn left at Sentinel Drive (after traveling 400 feet, look for CMP sign on right).

From Hwy 431 North.

1. Head south on AL-1/US-431 N towards McClellan Blvd for 4.1 miles.
2. Turn left at Greenbrier Dear Road and follow for 2.2 miles.
3. Turn right at Sentinel Drive (after traveling 400 feet, look for CMP sign on right).
