

CMP JUNIOR RIFLE CAMPS WEEK 3 ANNISTON, AL

Location: CMP South Competition Center, 1470 Sentinel Dr, Anniston, AL 36207
Dates: 22-26 June 2009
Start Time: 1300 Monday 22 June (No lunch provided on the first day)
Registration: Registration will be held at the range from 1130-1230. (This typically takes 10-15mins.)

Range Facilities:

The range will be located at the new air gun facility at CMP South Headquarters in Anniston, AL. This 84-point range is one of two new facilities that came online for CMP in 2008. It is scheduled to be equipped with state-of-the-art electronic targets by this summer, before the CMP camps begin. Rifles and equipment will be secured in the range at the conclusion of each day. The classroom is also located within the range.

Camp Options:

Participants are given the option to either attend camp as a resident or commuter camper. Residential campers are provided housing and meals at Jacksonville State University. Commuter campers are responsible for their own housing, and will only be provided lunches. Please indicate if you plan to attend camp as a resident or a commuter on your registration form, rates for the residential and commuter camps are listed in the **Costs** section of this program.

Housing:

Athletes and coaches attending camp as residents will be housed in dorms at Jacksonville State University, 700 Pelham Road North, Jacksonville, AL 36265. **Participants will check-in at the conclusion of the first day of camp on 22 June.** Please contact Sommer Wood prior to the start of camp if you have special rooming requests/needs. Dorm rooms are not furnished so participants will need to bring bed linens, towels, toiletries, and hair dryers. Internet access is available on campus, and participants will be allowed to use computers in the university library. **Camp staff will be housed at a different location and will not be responsible for the supervision of athletes in the residence halls; this will be the responsibility of their adult leader.** For more information about JSU visit the school's website at www.jsu.edu. Food:

For residential campers breakfast and dinner will be provided in the dining hall at JSU. The dining hall is a short walk from the dorms. Lunch for all campers will be provided at the range. Snacks will also be provided by CMP during classroom breaks. The first meal for residential campers will be dinner 22 June, and the last meal will be breakfast on 26 June. The first meal for commuters will be lunch on 23 June, and the last will be lunch on 25 June.

What to bring:

Campers must bring their own shooting equipment including but not limited to rifles, shooting clothing, slings, kneeling rolls, prone mats, pellets and journals. Do not bring spotting scopes, as all shooting will be done on electronic targets where shot locations are shown on monitors at the firing line. CO₂ and compressed air will be provided at the range, though it is recommended that individuals bring their own fill adapters. Campers need to make sure that they are dressed comfortably in athletic clothing and footwear because light physical training is incorporated into the daily program. Residential campers need to bring towels, toiletries, hair driers and any other personal items that they need for their dorm rooms.

Commuter Camp: Athletes: \$225, Adults: \$30

Residential Camp: Athletes: \$350, Adults: \$150

\$30 deposit and Medical Release forms are due with each participant's registration (Athlete and Adult Leader). Deadline for final payment is 24 April 2009, if payment is not received by the deadline the applicant will be dropped from camp.

If you need to cancel your reservation you must do so in writing 2 weeks prior to the start of your selected camp for a partial refund.
