**CMP JUNIOR RIFLE CAMPS**  
**WEEK 7**  
**MONMOUTH, OR**

**Location:** Western Oregon University, Monmouth, OR 97361  
**Dates:** 20-24 July 2009  
**Start Time:** 1300 Monday, 20 July, at range  
**Registration:** Registration will be held at the range from 1130-1230. (This typically takes 10-15mins.)

**Range Facilities:**

The Air Rifle Range will be located in the New Physical Education building on Church Street, across from McArthur Field, located on the campus of Western Oregon University. Signs will be posted directing campers to the range on the first day, and parking passes will be provided at registration. Rifles and equipment will be secured at the range each night. The classroom will be located within walking distance of the range.

**Camp Options:**

Participants are given the option to either attend camp as a resident or commuter camper. Residential campers are provided housing and meals at Western Oregon University. Commuter campers are responsible for their own housing, and will only be provided lunch at the University. Please indicate if you plan to attend camp as a resident or a commuter on your registration form, rates for the residential and commuter camps are provided in the **Costs** selection of this program.

**Housing:**

Athletes and coaches attending camp as residents will be housed in the dorms at Western Oregon University, Monmouth, OR 97361. Housing facilities are a short walk from the gym where the range will be set-up. **Participants will check into the dorms at the conclusion of the first day of camp on 20 July.** Please contact Sommer Wood prior to the start of camp if you have special rooming requests/needs. The University will provide bed linens and towels. Toiletries and hair dryers are not provided. The summers are very mild in Oregon, and dorms are not air-conditioned. It is recommended that you bring a small fan for your room. The showers are community showers on each hall, men and women will be housed on separate halls. It is recommended that you bring shower shoes. There are no TV's in rooms, but there is a community room in the dorms and student center that campers can use that has a TV and game tables. There is also a swimming pool, so it is recommended that campers bring swimsuits. **Camp staff will be housed at a different location and will not be responsible for the supervision of athletes in the residence halls; this will be the responsibility of their adult leader.** More information about Western Oregon University can be found at [www.wou.edu](http://www.wou.edu). Wireless internet access will be available for purchase at registration for \$15 for the week.

**Food:**

Meals will be provided in a dining hall on campus. Snacks will also be provided by CMP during classroom breaks. The first meal for residential campers will be dinner 20 July, and the last meal will be breakfast 24 July. The first meal for commuters will be lunch on 21 July, and the last will be lunch on 23 July.

**What to bring:**

Campers must bring their own shooting equipment including but not limited to rifles, shooting clothing, slings, kneeling rolls, prone mats, spotting scores, pellets and journals. CO<sub>2</sub> and compressed air will be provided at the range, though it is recommended that individuals bring their own fill adapters. Campers need to make sure that they are dressed comfortably in athletic clothing and footwear because light physical training is incorporated into the daily program. Residential campers please see Housing section above.

**Costs:**

Commuter Camp: Athletes: \$225, Adults: \$30

Residential Camp: Athletes: \$350, Adults: \$150

**\$30 deposit and Medical Release forms are due with each participant's registration (Athlete and Adult Leader). Deadline for final payment is 24 April 2009, if payment is not received by the deadline the applicant will be dropped from camp.**

If you need to cancel your reservation you must do so in writing 2 weeks prior to the start of your selected camp for a partial refund.
