

CMP JUNIOR RIFLE CAMPS

Location: Linn State Technical College, 1 Technology Drive, Linn, MO 65051
Dates: 27-31 July 2009
Start Time: 1300 Monday, 27 July, at range
Registration: Registration will be held at the range from 1130-1230. (This typically takes 10-15mins.)

Range Facilities:

The Air Rifle Range will be located in the Activities Center at Linn State Technical College. Rifles and equipment will be secured at the range each night. The classroom will be located within walking distance of the range.

Camp Options:

Participants are given the option to either attend camp as a resident or commuter camper. Residential campers are provided housing and meals at Linn State Technical College. Commuter campers are responsible for their own housing, and will only be provided lunch at the college. Please indicate if you plan to attend camp as a resident or a commuter on your registration form, rates for the residential and commuter camps are provided in the **Costs** selection of this program.

Housing:

Athletes and coaches attending camp as residents will be housed in the dorms at Linn State Technical College, 1 Technology Drive, Linn, MO 65051. A map to the housing facilities will be provided at check-in. **Participants will check-in at the conclusion of the first day of camp on 27 July.** Please contact Sommer Wood prior to the start of camp if you have special rooming requests/needs. Bed linens and towels will be provided in the dorms by the university, but participants will need to bring their own pillow. Wireless internet access is available on campus, and computers are open for camper use in the Student Activity Center. **Camp staff will be housed at a different location and will not be responsible for the supervision of athletes in the residence halls; this will be the responsibility of their adult leader.** More information about Linn State Technical College can be found at <http://www.linnstate.edu/>. Food:

Meals will be provided in the university's dining hall. Snacks will also be provided by CMP during classroom breaks. The first meal for residential campers will be dinner 27 July, and the last meal will be breakfast 31 July. The first meal for commuters will be lunch on 28 July, and the last will be lunch on 30 July.

What to bring:

Campers must bring their own shooting equipment including but not limited to rifles, shooting clothing, slings, kneeling rolls, prone mats, spotting scopes, pellets and journals. CO₂ and compressed air will be provided at the range, though it is recommended that individuals bring their own fill adapters. Campers need to make sure that they are dressed comfortably in athletic clothing and footwear because light physical training is incorporated into the daily program. Residential campers need to bring a pillow, toiletries, hair dyes and any other personal items that they need for their dorm rooms (bed linens and towels will be provided by the university).

Commuter Camp: Athletes: \$225, Adults: \$30

Residential Camp: Athletes: \$350, Adults: \$150

\$30 deposit and Medical Release forms are due with each participant's registration (Athlete and Adult Leader). Deadline for final payment is 24 April 2009, if payment is not received by the deadline the applicant will be dropped from camp.

If you need to cancel your reservation you must do so in writing 2 weeks prior to the start of your selected camp for a partial refund.
