INSTRUCTIONS: The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Smallbore Ammunition, Air Rifle Pellets and BB Purchase Program offers low-cost ammunition for sale to BSA Councils for use in Council riflery programs. This ammunition is available to BSA Councils at special, subsidized prices through a Memorandum of Agreement between the Boy Scouts of America and the CMP. Orders for ammunition that will be used in BSA Council camp or other programs may be submitted to the CMP by using this Order Form. Unlimited quantities of any ammunition item listed may be purchased. Orders may be sent at any time during the year, but should be submitted at least 30 days before the items are required to allow sufficient time for order processing and shipping.

Additional Information

CMP AMMUNITION, AIR RIFLE PELLET AND BB PURCHASE PROGRAM FOR BSA COUNCILS

- ⊙ **CMP Smallbore Ammunition, Air Pellets and BB Purchase Program.** The Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) established this program to make .22 cal. ammunition, air rifle pellets and BBs, that are especially suitable for youth firearm safety and rifle marksmanship programs, available for BSA Council camp riflery and other shooting sports programs at the lowest possible prices. The CMP does this through volume purchase contracts and subsidized prices. Eligibility to purchase smallbore ammunition, air rifle pellets or BBs through this program, is restricted to organizations with junior shooting programs that are affiliated with the CMP, including BSA Councils, JROTC units and County Extension Agents with 4-H Shooting Sports Clubs in their counties.
- ⊙ **Boy Scouts of America Councils.** The CMP and BSA have an agreement through which the CMP makes this program available to all BSA Councils. This program replaces the former Army DCM program through which BSA Councils purchased surplus government .22 cal. rimfire ammunition. Under this program, BSA Councils may purchase, at special prices directly from the CMP, rimfire ammunition, air rifle pellets or BBs for use in Council summer camp or other marksmanship and firearm safety training activities.
- ⊙ **Minimum Order Amounts.** Councils ordering ammunition from the CMP must submit a minimum order for at least one shipping unit of 3,250 rounds of .22-caliber ammunition or one shipping unit of 6,000 .177 cal. training grade pellets or one shipping unit of 5,000 .177 cal. competition grade air rifle pellets or one shipping unit of 18,000 BBs. Orders for more than these amounts must be for multiples of these basic shipping units.
- ⊙ **Maximum Order Amounts.** There are no maximum amounts that can be ordered through this program. As long as the ammunition, pellets or BBs are used by an authorized organization for youth firearms safety and marksmanship, the purchasing organization may order as many shipping units as they require.
- ⊙ **Order Deadlines.** There are no longer any annual deadlines for sending orders to the CMP. Orders may be submitted any time during the year, but should be submitted at least 30 days before the items are required to allow sufficient time for order processing and shipping. Prices listed on this form are effective through 31 December 2003.
- ⊙ **Smallbore Ammunition.** The smallbore ammunition available through this program is standard training grade .22 cal. rimfire ammunition manufactured by Federal Cartridge Co. To obtain the price and quality combination sought by the CMP, the ammunition is loaded to a velocity of 1250 fps. This velocity is higher than so-called standard velocity ammunition, however, the chamber pressures generated by this ammunition are well within SAAMI (industry) standards. This ammunition also meets rigid accuracy standards established by the CMP that require test groups where all shots would score tens on the 50 foot A-36 target used in junior competition programs. This ammunition has consistently met this standard in factory and CMP testing.
- ⊙ **Training Grade Pellets.** The training grade .177 cal. pellets available through this program are “superior match grade” pellets manufactured by Daisy Manufacturing. Training grade pellets available through the CMP must meet accuracy standards that require test groups where all shots will score tens or better on the 10 meter competition air rifle target (ISSF, AR-1). These pellets have consistently met this standard in CMP testing.
- ⊙ **Match Grade Pellets.** The match (competition) grade .177 cal. pellets available through this program are competition grade pellets manufactured by the H&N Company in Germany. Competition grade pellets available through the CMP must meet accuracy standards that require test groups that are significantly better than ten-ring groups on the 10-meter competition air rifle targets. These pellets have consistently met this standard in factory and CMP testing.
- ⊙ **BBs.** The BBs available through this program are “Premium Grade” BBs manufactured by Daisy Manufacturing. CMP testing of these BBs is done to ensure that they are capable of producing ten-ring groups on the 5-meter BB gun competition target in target-grade BB guns.
- ⊙ **Ordering Instructions.** To order ammunition, pellets or BBs through this program, BSA Councils should complete the order form on the front side of this form and send the completed form to the **CMP Affiliate Relations Department, P. O. Box 576, Port Clinton OH 43452 or to fax 419-635-2573.** Please include payment with the order.
- ⊙ **Shipping Information.** BBs are shipped from Daisy Manufacturing Co. in Rogers, AR. Smallbore ammunition and air rifle pellets are shipped from the CMP warehouse at Anniston, AL via FedEx Ground or Freight Collect. Orders for more than five shipping units of smallbore ammunition (5 x 3250 rounds) are encouraged to elect the “Freight Collect” shipping option. This will normally result in a savings in shipping expense. When exercising this option, do not include the shipping charges for smallbore ammunition with your payment.
- ⊙ **Picking Up Ammunition at CMP.** BSA Councils also have the option of picking up ammunition at the CMP warehouses at Camp Perry, Ohio (Port Clinton) or Anniston, Alabama. This will eliminate shipping charges for smallbore ammunition or air rifle pellets. Call the number below to make arrangements.
